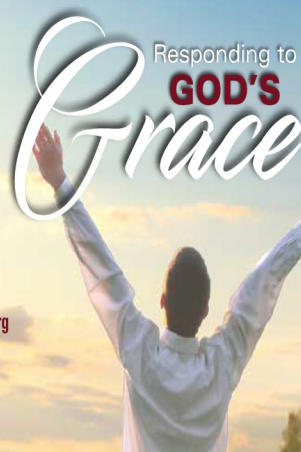

OLG School Advisory Council Opening

There is one opening on the OLG School Advisory Council for the 2019-2022 term (3 school years). This seven-member Council is responsible for monitoring the fiscal condition of the school, advising and assisting in the formulation of tuition, preparing the budget, mediation, program review, and serving as a conduit for information between OLG parents and the school. Meetings are held one evening a month, Sept through May, except Dec.

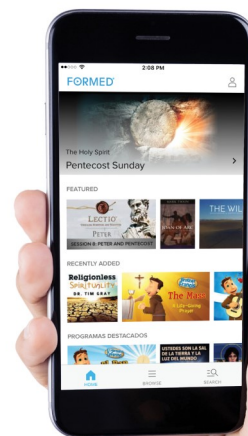
