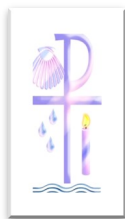

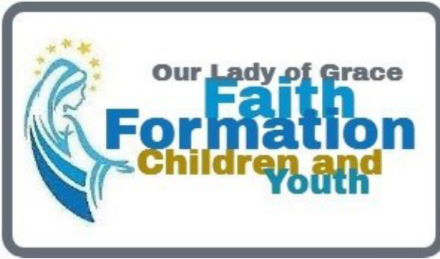
Invitation to the RCIA

Kinder through Junior High gather on Sunday mornings from 9:30 to 10:45 am.

Senior High first and second year Confirmation Preparation youth gather on Sunday evenings about *every other week* after the 5:30 Mass from 6:45 to 8:30 pm. Ask for our Confirmation preparation packet for details!

- Level 1 is the prerequisite for Penance/Reconciliation and First Eucharist prep.
- Confirmation prep is for those attending Catholic, private, public or home study grades 9, 10 or 11. Level 8 or Catholic school grade 8 is required to begin Confirmation prep.
- Home study opportunities are available. Parents teach the lessons at home and children gather during the year for Catechist reviews.

Faith Formation fees are subsidized by donations from the community of Our Lady of Grace. Parent portion of the fees are as follows:

One child: \$80.00 | Two children: \$115.00 | Each additional child: \$25.00

Add \$25.00 for Penance/Reconciliation & First Eucharist preparation materials

Please note: A fee increase is planned for June 30

- Fees are paid by exact cash, check, or credit card at the time of registration. Make checks payable to OLG. Fees can be paid online. Payment receipt to be presented at registration.
- If not already on file, a copy of child's Baptism Certificate is required for registration.
- No child or youth will be turned away for a lack of ability to pay a fee.
- K-Level 6 parents will teach some lessons at home during the Faith Formation year.

Parish-Wide Planning Study Begins!

As we continue to grow, it is important that we prepare to meet the needs of our community both now and in the years to come so that we all might encounter Christ more deeply in our lives. At this time, we are moving forward with a Planning Study to help us prepare for a capital campaign to renovate and update our parish campus.

In order to be good stewards of our resources, careful arrangement and thoughtful planning are required and the feedback of our parishioners is essential - in fact, it is paramount. Your participation in this study is an important factor in making this project a success. Your input will enable us to prepare a course of action so that together we can make educated projections concerning our future.

To assist us, we are working with Guidance In Giving, Inc., a professional Catholic fundraising and stewardship-consulting firm. They work only with Catholic parishes and schools, and together we will formulate a plan of action for the implementation of a successful campaign.

Every registered family will be mailed a personal invitation from Fr. Peter to participate in the Planning Study in one of three ways:

1. Personal interviews will be conducted over the next few weeks with a cross-section of our parish families. We ask all invited to an interview to please contact the parish office as soon as possible to schedule an appointment.
2. A Mail survey will be sent to “active” registered parishioners. All parishioners are asked to complete the Survey and return it back to the parish by the weekend of **Saturday, May 18th and Sunday, 19th: “Survey Weekend”**.
3. The proposed plans and Planning Study survey are also available online. To take the survey online, please follow the steps below.

 - Enter the password “planningstudy”

The findings from the Planning Study will give us a snapshot of the views and thoughts of the community as we discern the support that can be expected from parishioners as we consider our present and future needs of our entire campus.
