## CRS RESPONDS TO HISTORIC FLASH FLOODING IN KERALA, INDIA

## BALTIMORE, MD, Aug 20,

2018 -- The most extreme flash flooding and landslides in nearly a century have left hundreds of people dead and about 800,000 displaced in Kerala state, in southwest India. Catholic Relief Services (CRS), in collaboration with the government and local partners, is working quickly to provide emergency aid to thousands of families impacted by the disaster.

"People here have lost everything, including their cars, their keepsakes and their clothes. Many have even had their homes washed away by landslides. Others are coming back to find their homes in complete ruin," said Jomey Joseph, CRS' head of office in Chennai who is leading the agency's Kerala response. "People say they've never

witnessed so much rain in their lifetimes. Even those families who are better off have been devastated by this disaster."

In Kerala, monsoon season started as far back as June, although the rains didn't become severe until the beginning of August, when flash flooding caused rivers to overflow and nearly three dozen dams to be breached.

In addition to families losing their homes and belongings, food has become scarce in places like Wayanad District, in the northeastern part of Kerala state. Here people mostly survive on

agriculture and foraging, but the floods decimated crops and cut off access to forests. Clean drinking water is also an issue because most of the wells are contaminated.

"This part of Kerala is a tribal area where people are already socio-economically marginalized. The living conditions are substandard and the flooding is making a bad situation much worse," Jomey said. "You have families who don't even have access to a dry change of clothes."

CRS is providing assistance to more than 2,000 families in Wayanad District, one of the hardest hit and isolated areas impacted by the flooding. CRS distributions include:

- Water purifying tablets for clean drinking water
- · Buckets for safe water storage
- Hygiene items, such as soap and sanitary napkins
- Shelter kits that include tarps and blankets

The government of India estimates that the damage caused by the flash flooding and landslides will cost more than \$1.1 billion U.S. dollars.

"Even though the rain has started to let up, people are in urgent need of assistance, and will be for the foreseeable future," Jomey

## Seeking a Catechist for Faith Formation



Do you have a deep love for your faith and desire to share it with children? Consider being a catechist! Though it may be helpful, previous teaching experience is not necessary. And don't be afraid that you don't know every detail of your faith—part of being a catechist involves openness to learning as you teach.

**One catechist is needed for our Level 4 (around age 9) students.** As a catechist, you make a commitment to teach 23 sessions from mid-September to mid-April guiding a class of about 15 students through their *Finding God* Loyola Press text book. Classes are on Sundays from 9:30 to 10:45 am. Catechists are asked to arrive by 9:15 am and stay until the children are picked up (usually by 10:55 am).

When you make a commitment to serve, we make a commitment to support you in your ministry. As a catechist, you will receive a schedule for the year, which will help you plan when to teach which lesson. You will also receive the catechist's version of the text book, which suggests activities and gives tips on how to plan your lesson. You'll also review the Catechist Handbook for guidance on classroom safety and church policies. Catechists are responsible for planning and presenting weekly lessons and we provide a session assistant to help pass out supplies, help children with their activities and companioning children to the restroom or office. A background check and completion of the diocesan online Safe Environment Module are required.


