

#### Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### **Mass Readings:**

Dt 4:1-2, 6-8 Jas 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27 Mk 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

**GROW:** As I began reading the Gospel for today, I initially thought, "Here we go - those hypocritical Pharisees are at it again! They are always questioning Jesus, always judging others, and always looking for ways to make themselves look 'holier' than everyone else." Uh oh; then I realized that I was feeling pretty smug as I judged the Pharisees! Sadly, it can be easy for me to fall into a "Pharisee attitude," thinking I "walk blamelessly and do justice" when really I am just deluding myself. While Jesus uses this encounter to point out the hypocrisy of the Pharisees, he also calls the crowd to a greater understanding of the source of evil in their lives, "From within people, from their hearts, come evil thoughts." Maybe I need to hear these words, too, and examine my own thoughts and actions before judging others

**GO:** St. James provides an answer to combating the evil we discover in our hearts: "Humbly welcome the word that has been



planted in you and is able to save your souls." The Word, Jesus, came to us and has given us the way to free ourselves from the

evil within. Our relationship with him is the key. We know we are to "be doers of the word and not hearers only." We have the Holy Spirit to help us stay close to him and access his saving power that transforms our hearts to reflect his goodness and truth. It requires us to humbly assess and own the things we need to change; and to turn to him for guidance so that we may have nothing within us - no evil thoughts, greed, malice, envy or arrogance (etc.) to defile us. Only then are we most free in Christ truly free to "care for orphans and widows in their affliction and to keep oneself unstained by the world."

PRAY: The Daily Examen, created by St. Ignatius of Loyola, is an ideal way for growing closer to Jesus and seeking his guidance. Suggested for the day's end, this prayerful reflection helps you recognize God's presence in the day's events, assess your thoughts and behavior, ask for his help in growing in goodness, and discern his plans for you.

#### **Sharing Your Faith**

#### Question:

My friend has never heard of Christ and I want to share the Gospel with her but I'm afraid to. How do I share my faith?

#### Answer:

There are a lot of ways to bring up the topic of religion, without being judgmental or pushy. Begin by asking what her thoughts are about religion, or what her experi-

ence was growing up. Finding common ground is often easier than you think, because the questions and problems we have about God, the presence of evil, our purpose in life, and our relationship with always at work and our most humble God are universal concerns.

Why are you afraid? If you do not want

to insult or offend someone, don't be pushy or judgmental. If you are uncertain about how to explain your own faith, do a little reading or practice with a friend. If you measure success only by this person converting, focus your atten-

> tion more on beginning the conversation, not on bringing it to a perfect close! Faith is a journey of many acts of belief, many discussions about God, and many choices about how we practice what we preach. In

some we will have great success; in others we will need forgiveness and perseverance. The most important thing to keep in mind is that the Holy Spirit is efforts can bear great fruit. Have faith in God because he has faith in you!





Heavenly Father, we thank you for the life of your servant and Martyr, St. Florian. He courageously gave his life rather than betray the name of your Son, Jesus. Grant that we too may imitate his unwavering faith and come to share in the glory of heaven. 




