Traditionally, Advent wreaths are constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which four candles are inserted, representing the four weeks of Advent. Three candles are purple and one is rose, but white candles can also be used.



The progressive lighting of the candles symbolizes the expectation and hope surrounding our Lord's first coming into the world and the anticipation of his second coming to judge the living and the dead.

#### 1ST CANDLE: (PURPLE—DEC 3) The Prophecy Candle or Candle of Hope

We can have hope because God is faithful and will keep the promises made to us. Our hope comes from God. (Romans 15:12-13)

#### 2ND CANDLE: (PURPLE—DEC 10) The Bethlehem Candle or The Candle of Preparation, also known as the Candle of Love

God kept his promise of a Savior who would be born in Bethlehem. Preparation means to "get ready." Help us to be ready to welcome YOU, O GOD! (Luke 3:4-6)

#### 3RD CANDLE: (ROSE—DEC 17) The Shepherd Candle or the Candle of Joy

The angels sang a message of JOY! (Luke 2:7-15)

#### 4TH CANDLE: (PURPLE—DEC 24) The Angel Candle or the Candle of Peace

The angels announced the good news of a Savior. God sent his only Son to earth to save us, because he loves us! (John 3:16-17)
