



ur Lady of Lourdes is a title of the Blessed Virgin Mary, invoked by Roman Catholics in honor of the Marian Apparition that took place in Lourdes, France. St. Bernadette Soubirous was a fourteen-year-old peasant girl that witnessed Our Lady's apparition. There were a total of seventeen apparitions over the year 1858. Our Lady told St. Bernadette that we were to pray for the Conversion of Sinners, and she stated, "I am the Immaculate Conception". St. Bernadette was asked to dig in the ground and a "spring" would erupt. She did as she was told, and to this day the water runs. Nearly 6 million faithful make the pilgrimage annually, and hundreds of miracles have been reported through these visits. Our Lady of Lourdes' feast day is on February 11.


