W elcome to all members and visitors who are joining us for the

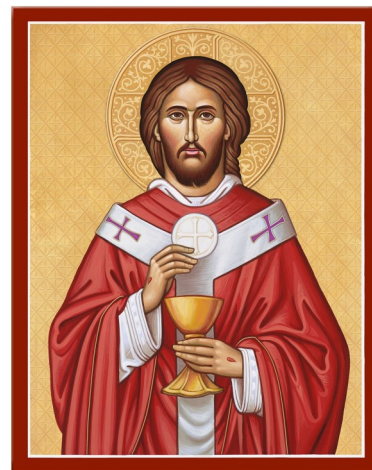
celebration of the Eucharist.

If you feel drawn to the Catholic Church yet come from another faith tradition - or have no faith experience at all - we are glad you are here!

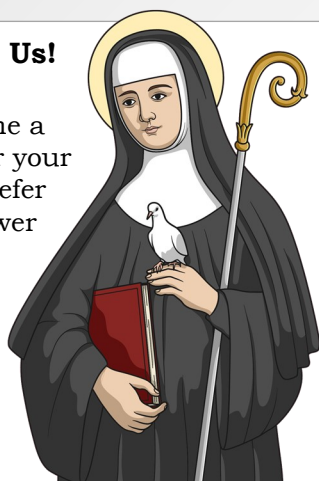
