

Dear Parishioners,

With the onset of a stronger-than-normal flu season this year, I'd like to share with you a few ways OLG is working to limit the spread of contagion:

- Communion will be offered in the form of consecrated bread alone.
- Consider receiving the host in the hand rather than by the mouth.
- Ministers, including priests, deacons, sacristans, servers and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, are reminded to practice good hygiene by washing their hands before Mass. Hand sanitizer is available at the credence table for those ministers to use before and after the distribution of communion.
- Parishioners are never under an obligation to shake hands with others during the Sign of Peace; a statement of peace, bow or other gesture is appropriate.
- It is not necessary to hold hands for the Lord's Prayer. While commonly done, this gesture is not prescribed by the *Roman Missal*.
- Anyone who is ill, or suspects oncoming symptoms, is legitimately excused from attending Mass. Those who are sick may wish to watch a broadcast of the Sunday Mass on their TV or over the Internet at home and pray in solidarity with the parish community.

Thank you for understanding. Once the flu season is over, around the end of March, we will reinstitute our traditional means of sharing the Sign of Peace and parish norm of distributing communion from the cup at each celebration of the Eucharist. OUR LADY OF GRACE CHURCH
