

FROM *the* PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

With the onset of a stronger-than-normal flu season this year, I'd like to share with you a few ways OLG will work to limit the spread of contagion starting on Mon, Jan 8:

- Communion will be offered in the form of consecrated bread alone.
- Consider receiving the host in the hand rather than by the mouth.
- Ministers, including priests, deacons, sacristans, servers and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, are reminded to practice good hygiene by washing their hands before Mass. Hand sanitizer is available at the credence table for those ministers to use before and after the distribution of communion.
- Parishioners are never under an obligation to shake hands with others during the Sign of Peace; a statement of peace, bow or other gesture is appropriate.
- It is not necessary to hold hands for the Lord's Prayer. While commonly done, this gesture is not prescribed by the *Roman Missal*.
- Anyone who is ill, or suspects oncoming symptoms, is legitimately excused from attending Mass. Those who are sick may wish to watch a broadcast of the Sunday Mass on their TV or over the Internet at home and pray in solidarity with the parish community.

Thank you for understanding. Once the flu season is over, around the end of March, we will reinstitute our traditional means of sharing the Sign of Peace and parish norm of distributing communion from the cup at each celebration of the Eucharist.



In addition, I am very pleased to announce that Colin Barkley is now serving as our Director of Liturgical Music on an interim basis until a permanent hire is made. Many of you are already familiar with Colin as he has served as one of our parish cantors and choir section leader since 2015. Graduating from the University of San Diego in 2014 with a B.A. in Music with an Emphasis in

Composition, Colin is also a four-year member of SACRA/PROFANA, a San Diego-based choral group committed to enhancing the cultural life of Southern California by cultivating and promoting the art of choral singing throughout our communities. He is an accomplished music composer, has experience in conducting, and is also an instructor for piano, voice and bass.

Please join me in welcoming Colin to the pastoral ministry team at OLG!

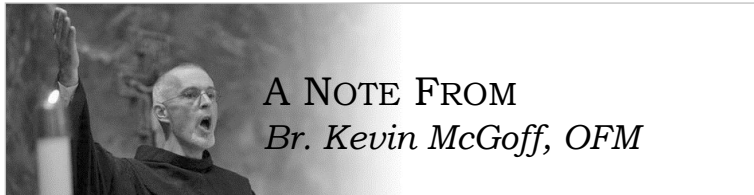
