Faith Formation and the Crazy Family Calendar

e hope for every child to be an active participant in faith formation through their grade school and high school years, and trust that every adult member of our parish engages in an active discipleship in the parish, that includes weekly Mass participation, ongoing formation and spiritual growth.

We know it can be hard. We want to give our families the best, and in the process sometimes we are scheduled in so many things that we begin to pull back on some activities thinking "what can be cut out because there's too much going on, we can't be everywhere at the same time". This works for the short term but at some point, parents need to look at longer term goals.

We choose to give our children music lessons, pay sports team fees, etc. These prepare them to be physically and mentally strong. What do we do to equip our children to get into heaven,

that which is so much more long-lasting?

I have read about studies that show young people who have faith participate less frequently in at risk behaviors and in general are happier, and more well-adjusted. They tend to be more generous and compassionate, qualities that are of great value/need in society. They feel part of the Body of Christ and it makes a difference. As parents, where do we want our children to be spiritually at 21? at 35? at 75?!

With a bulging family calendar, we may feel we can reduce Mass attendance and cut out Faith Formation after a child receives First Communion.

The Church teaches that forming our faith and being a participating member of a parish community is a *lifelong journey*.

The question is, "Why would anyone want their child to receive Baptism, Reconciliation and Eucharist and then withdraw from praying and serving

with the Christian community?" What is lost when years later parents want them to kindle a desire for the Sacrament of Confirmation? If we are going to build families of faith, if being a Catholic Christian is going to be more than another optional tick box on the family calendar, then we need to consistently be Church together.

Faith Formation gives our children - and ourselves - permission to explore our faith, wrestle with our faith, and grow in our faith - and that offers great hope for our children and our Church!

We know life happens. But I am happy to say that there are home study options for families with shared custody and other immovable calendar challenges. Register your child/ren for Faith Formation peer communities now!


