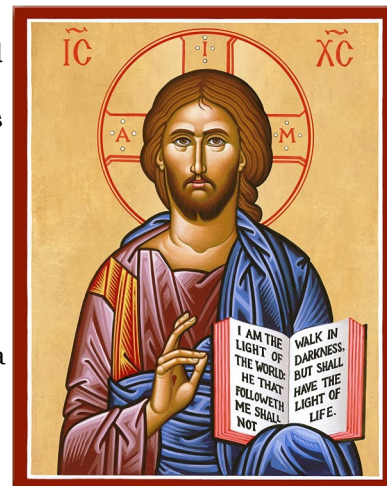
>Welcome to all members and visitors who are joining us for the celebration of the Eucharist.

## Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

**Dt 8:2-3, 14b-16a**  
**1 Cor 10:16-17**  
**Jn 6:51-58**

**GROW:** Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, the true, real, and substantial presence of Jesus Christ under the appearances of bread and wine. As Catholics, we know that the Eucharist is not simply symbolic, but is in fact the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Christ who rose from the dead. Our readings remind us of this. In the Gospel Jesus says: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh ... I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." Although Jesus' words were very difficult for his disciples at the time to understand, we know that the bread and wine that become the body and blood of Jesus satisfy our deepest hunger. This spiritual food is actually an encounter with



God through his Son, Jesus. It is a blessing that the Church provides us. Let us celebrate on this solemnity by giving thanks, which is what eucharist means!

**GO:** There was a priest at my home parish who could spend hours – literally, hours – sitting in eucharistic adoration. If he wasn't out and about serving our parish or in his office for a meeting, you would find him in the adoration chapel gazing at the monstrance which displayed the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament. He always would have a

small smile on his face, happily losing himself in the Lord. Although everyone has different time pressures on them during the course of a typical week, I think we can all agree that spending only one hour a week with someone is not enough to maintain an important relationship. The same is true with our relationship with Christ. Let's make an effort in the coming weeks to enhance that relationship by spending more time with him. Do you have an hour for adoration? Experience the peace it can bring. Or perhaps now is the time to check the daily Mass schedule in your parish and try to attend once or twice. Jesus offers us his very body and blood under the appearances of bread and wine. Don't squander the opportunity to receive this precious gift.

**ACTION:** As part of the National Eucharistic Revival, many dioceses around the country will hold Eucharistic processions for this solemn feast. This is a family-friendly activity. See what is planned in your diocese.

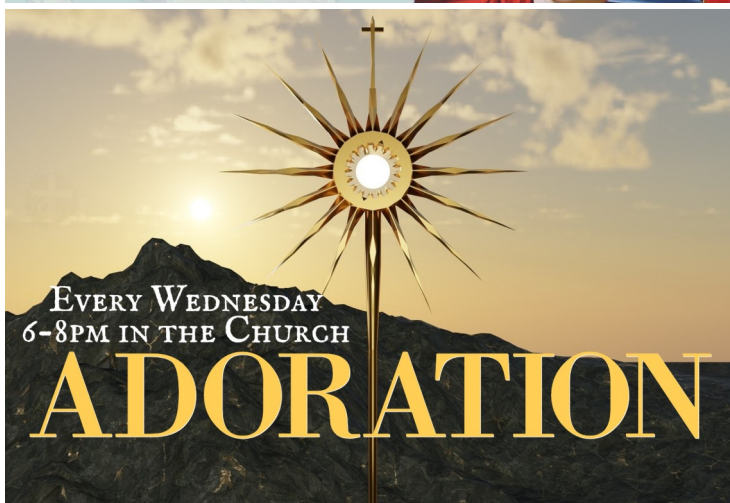

**Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Grace,**

My name is Father Marc Gandolfo. I was born in Oceanside on August 23, 1994, to two loving parents, JoAnn and Richard Gandolfo. I have 3 older siblings, who are all married and starting families of their own. As a child I attended Catholic school at St. Francis of Assisi in Vista and became heavily involved with my family at the parish. I was an altar server and took full advantage of every opportunity to help out around the parish. After the passing of my mother when I was in 7th grade, the family dynamic started to change, which caused a spiraling of changes over the next couple of years, such as moving to San Marcos, going to public school, and making new friends. After graduating high school, I attended community college for one year to study broadcast journalism, followed by a year of working for a traveling youth ministry organization named Reach, where I and a team of young adults led retreats for high school Confirmation students. After that, I worked for a year as coordinator of youth ministry at St. Francis in Vista.



During my time in youth ministry, I started to discern what vocation God was calling me to. As I started to build a prayer life and strengthen my relationship with God, I began to realize a possible call to the priesthood. I then went through the application process and was accepted into the program for priestly formation. I spent the next 3 years living at the house of formation, St. Francis Center, located on the campus of the University of San Diego where I studied philosophy. After graduating in 2019 with a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy with a minor in Theology, I was sent to Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon for four years of Theological studies and formation. I was ordained as a Transitional Deacon on December 17, 2022, at Mater Dei Parish, and I was ordained a priest on June 2, 2023, at Good Shepherd Parish. After many years in the program of priestly formation for the Diocese of San Diego, my passion and zeal for a life of priestly service continue to deepen as my relationship with Christ increases in intimacy. Having concluded my theological studies and finally ordained a priest, I feel a greater sense of excitement and joy about what future plans the Lord has for me. I know these experiences will help me to always continue to grow closer to our Lord and they will lead me to a life of sacrifice, service, and love for you, the people of God.

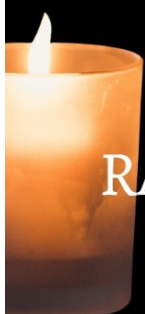

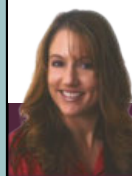

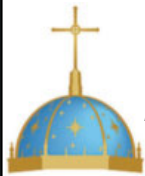
