Welcome to all who are joining us for the celebration of the Eucharist. There are many ways and parish organizations to participate in our life in Christ. See the directory on page 7.

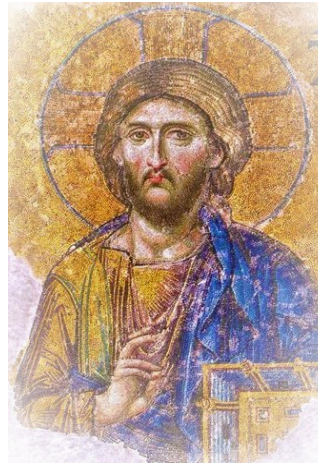

Our Addiction to Fear

“**F**ear no one,” Jesus says. Not long after, he nuances this command: Fear only the one who can destroy the soul along with the body. Soul killing may sound esoteric, but it’s pretty common nowadays. At times it feels like someone has murdered the soul of America while no one was looking. We are a nation shuddering in an environmental soup of crisis. We live in fear that’s stoked by every news crawl, renewed with each banner headline. And as Pope Francis points out, fear makes us cruel. The pope says fear is what drives a community to build walls, deny the other, and abandon the poor. What are we so afraid of—we who are still arguably the most powerful and secure nation on earth—that we should surrender our better natures?

The list of what folks around us live in dread of is long, starting with the uncertainties of this season of pandemic. Asian Americans fear being blamed for a suspected conspiracy of global sickness. Whites are always afraid of what blacks may do, and vice versa. The undocumented worker fears the citizen,

just as the citizen blames the newcomer for his misfortunes. Native Americans fear the destruction of land and water, the desecration of Mother Earth, which they hold to be their primary stewardship. Muslims (and those mistaken for Muslims because of their foreign-seeming dress or speech) are wary of sudden violence, or exclusion from the American story altogether. Blue-collar workers are hostile to professionals who appear to denigrate their contribution or forget them altogether. Business and church both fear government, with its power to legislate away their values. In fact, anyone who doesn’t fit a 19th-century definition of “belonging” on the American landscape has reason to suspect his or her safety is in doubt.

In recent years, nearly all of us have been in conversations that end badly, because of our deep divisions. There may be family members we don’t talk to, friends who don’t receive even a virtual welcome. Faith-filled Catholics report how tired they are from

carrying an anxiety that shifts from the back burner to the front with every news report. We’re reminded that Jesus not only says, “Fear no one,” but elsewhere he declares, “Fear is useless” (Luke 8:50, 1970 NAB translation). To which he appends the important dictum: “What is needed is faith.”

The anxieties of the present are real. But every act of generosity we extend robs them of their authority. Virtues like love, kindness, and inclusion defeat the power of fear that seeks to

kill the soul. The mandate to protect the common good, which assures everyone gets what they need even in a time of scarcer resources, heals division and clears the path toward a more gracious future. If what is needed is faith, then, O Lord, increase our faith! Let’s recall too that faith isn’t about believing certain things. It’s about trusting in the God who believes in us enough to entrust the welfare of our neighbor into our care.

A special Triduum of Masses will be celebrated at OLG on **Jun 25-27** for fathers, living and deceased.



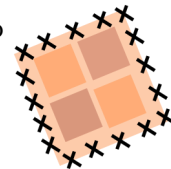

**Father's Day Prayer**

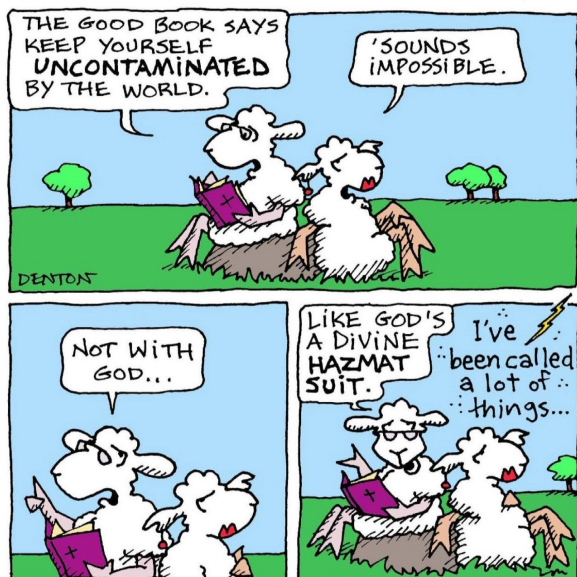
The following prayer may be used prior to the Grace Before Meals or at the conclusion of dinner.

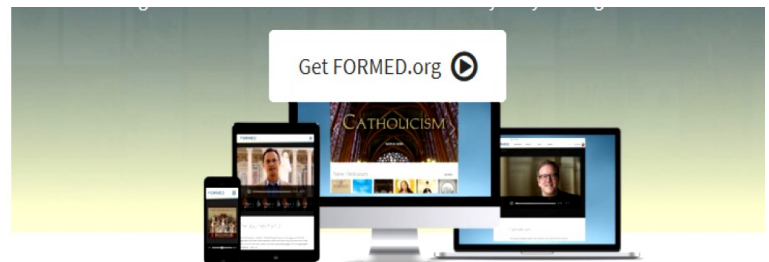

Happy Father's Day!

A Spiritual Bouquet with St. Joseph, Patron of Fathers

On the weekend of Father's Day (June 20-21), you are invited to write a prayer intention on a slip of paper and place it, along with a flower or some other type of gift, beneath a statue, icon, or image of St. Joseph. (If you don't have one, you could look for an image online to print or temporarily display on a screen.)

Directions

1. Gather your materials. Look around your own yard for flowers or greenery that might be available. If constructing a homemade box, do so a day or so ahead of time.
2. Set up a small table for your spiritual bouquet. Place on the table your statue or image of St. Joseph with a small basket, homemade keepsake box, or other container for prayer intentions and a vase with water or other receptacle for your little gifts. Have writing utensils and a hard surface to write on available nearby.

3. Pre-cut notecards or small slips of paper.
4. Invite household members to participate in the spiritual bouquet. Participants can write down on the notecards or slips of paper what they would like to ask St. Joseph to intercede for. They can then be invited to place their prayer intentions in the basket, as well as to place their flowers or other gifts in the vase or other receptacle in honor of St. Joseph.
5. When all participants have presented their prayer intentions and gifts to St. Joseph, offer a prayer of your choosing for your own intentions and for all fathers—especially those who are reluctant to offer loving, life-affirming support to the mothers of their unborn children.
6. Encourage family members to pray throughout the week for all the intercessions placed under the care of St. Joseph.
