


The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

GROW: Today’s feast is set apart to reverence the gift of Jesus in the Eucharist. In our limited human capacity, this concept can feel abstract, and we may struggle to understand it. In these moments, I find that pondering the person of Jesus Christ in the Gospels illuminates my mind and heart. Hearing the familiar story of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes in today’s Gospel, I’m particularly struck by the first line of the passage: “Jesus spoke to the crowds about the kingdom of God, and he healed those who needed to be cured.” Notice that Luke doesn’t say that Jesus heals *everyone*, rather, he heals those who *need* to be cured. This is not an act of favoritism, but a revelation of his perfect divine wisdom and a glimpse into the true person of

Jesus Christ. In his great mercy and perfect love, Jesus knew instantly what each person needed. And this Jesus, who came to heal and cure, is the one we receive in the Eucharist today.

GO: Today’s feast is a reminder of the staggering truth that 2,000 years later, at every Eucharistic celebration in Catholic churches around the world, Christ becomes truly present. The same Jesus of the Gospels who taught the crowds,

multiplied the



loaves, and gave himself completely on the cross, gives himself to us today, body blood, soul and divinity. We are not unlike the crowds in today’s Gospel — we have come with our hopes and needs to encounter Jesus. Today, at this table, no one goes hungry; Jesus meets our needs by giving us his unconditional love while nourishing us both physically and spiritually. We can be reassured that God is always present in our lives.



REFLECT: In a special way today, reflect on the Eucharist, the “source and summit of the Christian life.” The word Eucharist comes from Greek and Latin words for “thanksgiving.” Pray with a grateful heart today that Jesus, the Bread of Life, makes himself truly present to us.


Soul of Christ, sanctify me.

What is the Sacred Heart Devotion?

The devotion began in the 1670s, when Jesus appeared multiple times to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a Visitation nun in France. Through these visions, He told her how He wished to be honored with the symbol of His heart, asking for the faithful to make amends for any wrongdoing they had done, frequently take Communion, and observe the Holy Hour. In 1856, the devotion was added to the church calendar by Pope Pius IX. Pope Pius XII explained that the devotion to the Sacred Heart is connected to our worship of Christ as God incarnate.



Jesus's profound love for us is demonstrated through His willingness to sacrifice His life for our sake. The love from His heart motivated all His actions — His inner life manifested in His demonstrated virtues and sacrifice. Yet this great love is often received with ingratitude, even by the faithful. The purpose of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is to focus our hearts on receiving and returning His love

with gratitude — with all of our heart, soul, and strength — that He may be glorified.

Ignatian Spirituality Project San Diego


What is ISP? It is short for Ignatian Spirituality Project which invites men and women experiencing homelessness and recovery from addiction to encounter God's love, hope, and healing through spiritual companionship that transforms lives.

The practice of ISP is based on St. Ignatius of Loyola and the 12-step Program. We take them on a Spiritual journey to an Overnight Retreat, Follow-up Retreat, and Spiritual Reflection. During these Spiritual Journeys they are hosted at Mission San Luis Rey in Oceanside where they meditate, pray, and share about their sacred stories and fellowships.

Together with the facilitators and women and men (separately) from Fr Joe's Village, Rachel's Promise, Uptown Safe Haven, United Methodist Church, La Mesa, Lutheran Church, Santee, and Voices of Our City Choir, they have bonded to support one another and shared their sacred stories with each other.

We often hear people saying, "I'm thankful for the healing I gained and for that I was able to open up about my own story and be accepted." And, "The Spiritual Reflection opened my heart and opened my ears." And more.

All ISP retreats are offered free of charge. We depend on the support of our communities to make retreats possible through donations and sponsors. We also request volunteer drivers, spiritual companionship, hospitality and your support and prayers to bring our neighbors to a sacred space. You may check our website at ispretreats.org. 
