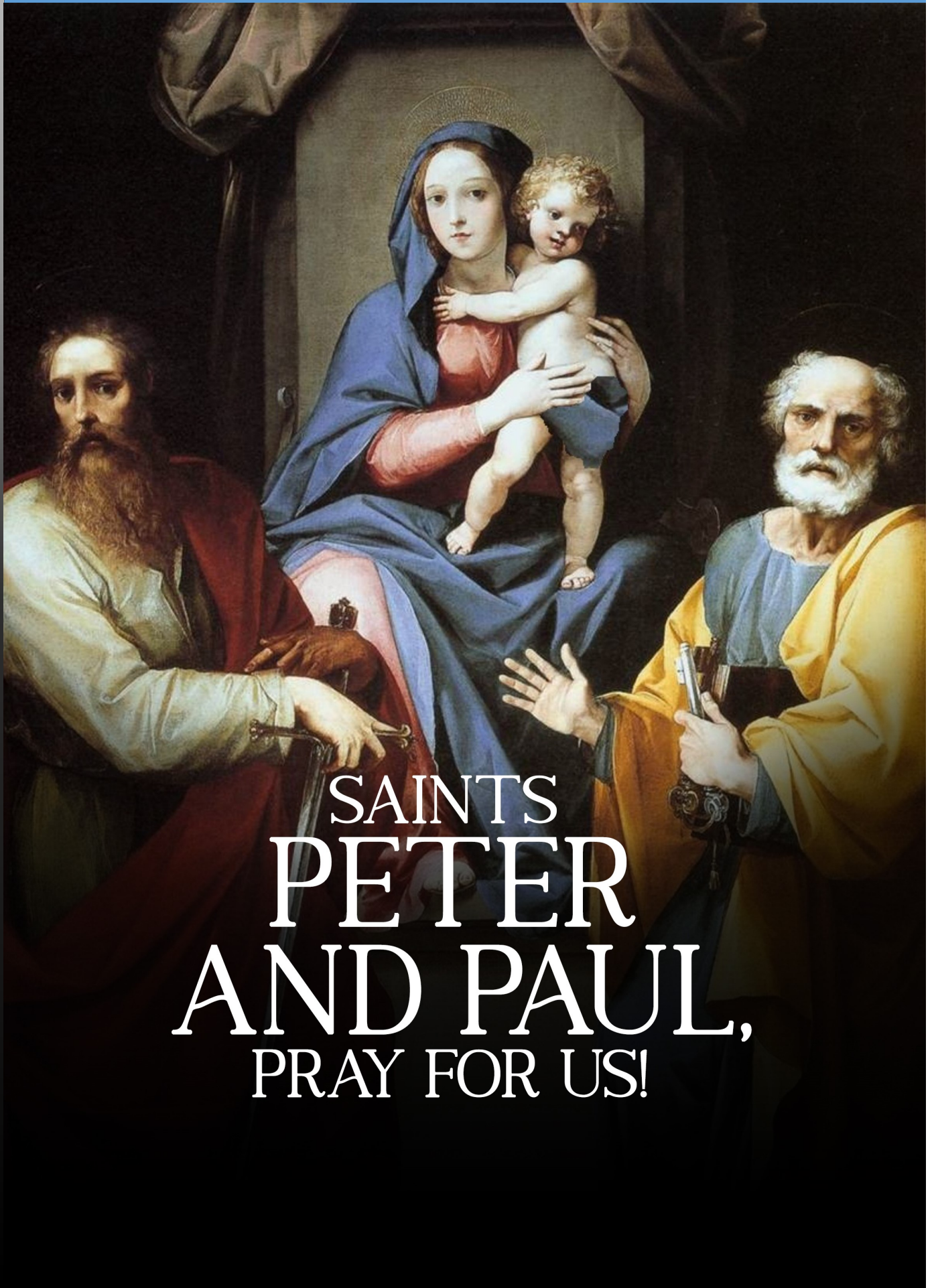

Solemnity of Saints Peter & Paul, Solemnity

GROW: Too often, we conceive of our earthly pilgrimage as a convoluted maze we must travel by ourselves. Consequently, many of us either ignore the question altogether or become overwhelmed by how ill-equipped we are for the task. But in today's Gospel, Jesus indicates that confusion was never part of his plan. Responding to Peter's profession of faith, Jesus says, "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church." From the mouth of Eternal Wisdom comes words which establish a Church on Peter's God-given faith. Already a leader among the disciples, Peter now receives his vocation to be the foundation of unity among the Apostles. Their successors, the bishops, would be recognizable by their union with Peter's successors, the popes. Over time, the Church's

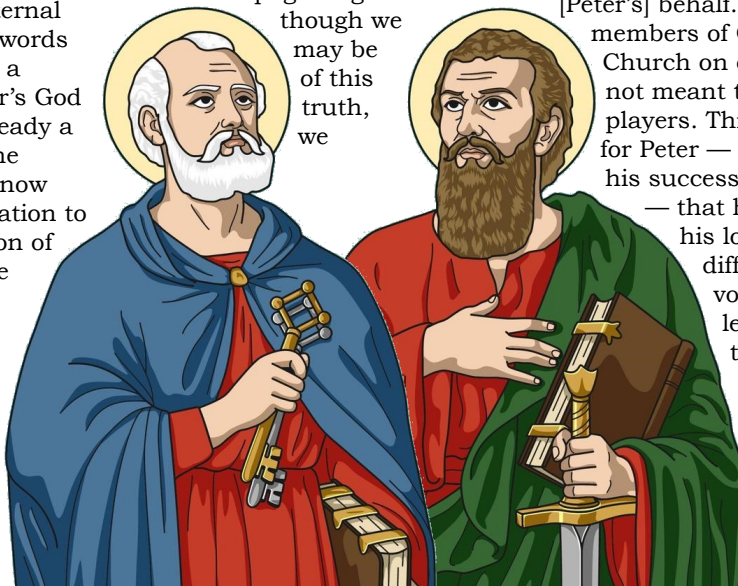
understanding of Peter's authority would mature and deepen. From the beginning, however, Peter's role as shepherd meant that navigating the path to heaven was not something we were to do in isolation. We aren't asked to decipher the meaning of the Scriptures ourselves or to untangle centuries of theological speculation in order to follow Jesus. God, who knows we cannot make the journey alone, has given us a visible Church to be our guide.

GO: Jesus established the Church so that we would have a sure and safe means of transit on our earthly pilgrimage. Convinced though we may be of this truth, we

nevertheless have to contend with the storms that buffet her from within and without. Yet we can rest in Jesus' assurance to Peter: "the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it." The Church has survived for millennia as empires have risen and fallen around her. Even in her darkest hours, Christ has continued to speak through her and, by his sacraments, to touch us intimately with his love

PRAY: Today's first reading, which takes place when Peter is in prison, contains an interesting detail: "Prayer by the Church was fervently being made to God on [Peter's] behalf." As members of Christ's Church on earth, we are not meant to be passive players. This week, pray for Peter — that is, for his successor, the pope — that he may fulfill his lofty and difficult vocation to lead the world to Christ.

Ignatian Spirituality Project San Diego

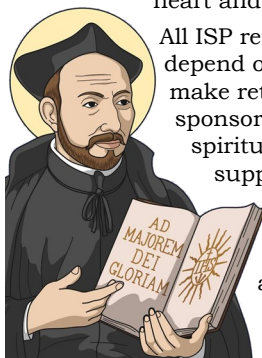
What is ISP? It is short for Ignatian Spirituality Project which invites men and women experiencing homelessness and recovery from addiction to encounter God's love, hope, and healing through spiritual companionship that transforms lives.

The practice of ISP is based on St. Ignatius of Loyola and the 12-step Program. We take them on a Spiritual journey to an Overnight Retreat, Follow-up Retreat, and Spiritual Reflection. During these Spiritual Journeys they are hosted at Mission San Luis Rey in Oceanside where they meditate, pray, and share about their sacred stories and fellowships.

Together with the facilitators and women and men (separately) from Fr Joe's Village, Rachel's Promise, Uptown Safe Haven, United Methodist Church, La Mesa, Lutheran Church, Santee, and Voices of Our City Choir, they have bonded to support one another and shared their sacred stories with each other.

We often hear people saying, "I'm thankful for the healing I gained and for that I was able to open up about my own story and be accepted." And, "The Spiritual Reflection opened my heart and opened my ears." And more.

All ISP retreats are offered free of charge. We depend on the support of our communities to make retreats possible through donations and sponsors. We also request volunteer drivers, spiritual companionship, hospitality and your support and prayers to bring our neighbors to a sacred space. You may check our website at ispretreats.org. 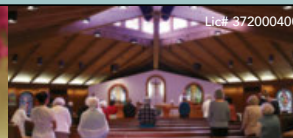
