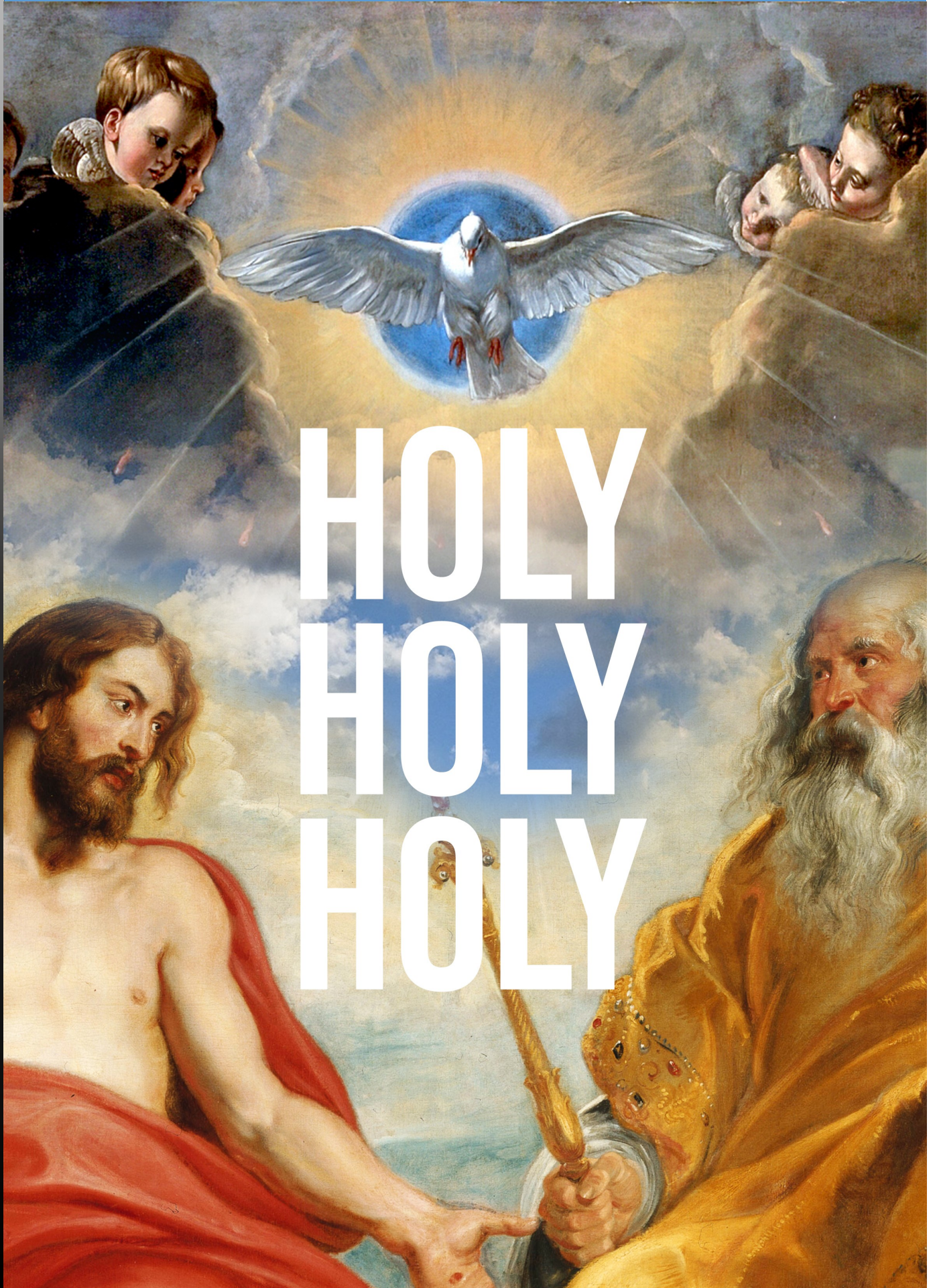

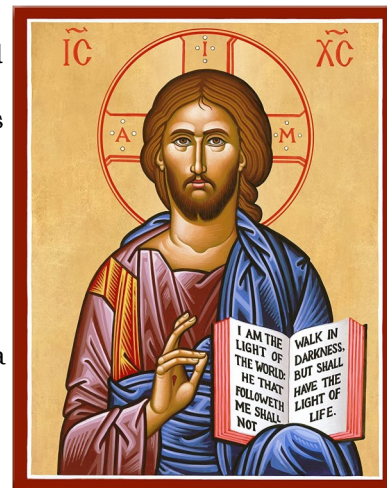
Welcome to all members and visitors who are joining us for the celebration of the Eucharist.

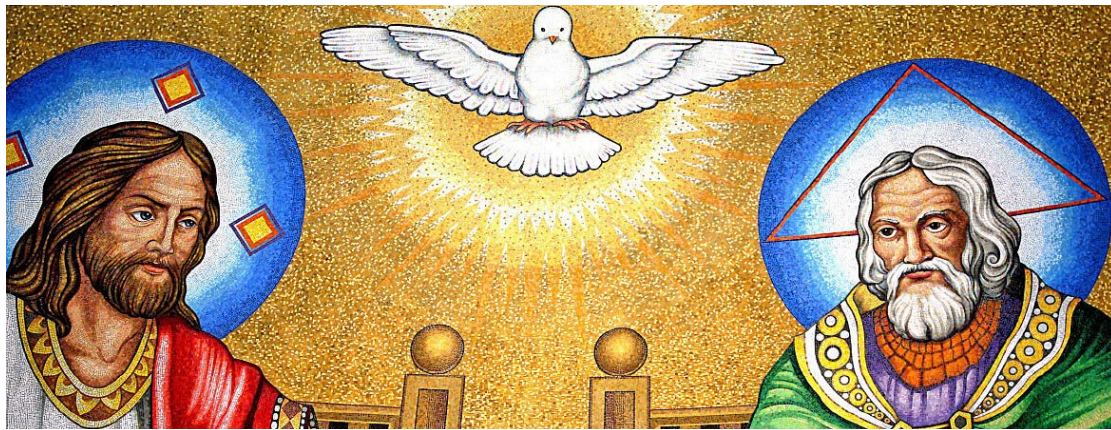

The Most Holy Trinity

We often begin Mass with the prayer from today’s Epistle: “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.” We praise the God who has revealed Himself as a Trinity, a communion of persons.

Communion with the Trinity is the goal of our worship—and the purpose of the salvation history that begins in the Bible and continues in the Eucharist and sacraments of the Church.

We see the beginnings of God’s self-revelation in today’s First Reading, as He passes before Moses and cries out His holy name. Israel had sinned in worshipping the golden calf (see Exodus 32). But God does not condemn them to perish. Instead, He proclaims His

mercy and faithfulness to His covenant.

God loved Israel as His firstborn son among the nations (see Exodus 4:22). Through Israel—heirs of His covenant with Abraham—God planned to reveal Himself as the Father of all nations (see Genesis 22:18).

The memory of God’s covenant testing of Abraham—and Abraham’s faithful obedience—lies behind today’s Gospel.

In commanding Abraham to offer his only beloved son (see Genesis 22:2, 12, 16), God was preparing us for the fullest possible revelation of His love for the world.

As Abraham was willing to offer Isaac, God did not spare His own Son but handed Him over for us all (see Romans 8:32).

In this, He revealed what was only disclosed partially to Moses—that His kindness continues for a thousand generations, that He forgives our sin, and that He takes us back as His very own people (see Deuteronomy 4:20; 9:29).

Jesus humbled himself to die in obedience to God’s will. And for this, the Spirit of God raised Him from the dead (see Romans 8:11), and gave Him a name above every name (see Philippians 2:8–10).

This is the name we glorify in today’s Responsorial—the name of our Lord, the God who is Love (see 1 John 4:8, 16).

Specifically, have as your at-the-ready prayer this week for all circumstances, the following: Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Grace,

My name is Father Marc Gandolfo. I was born in Oceanside on August 23, 1994, to two loving parents, JoAnn and Richard Gandolfo. I have 3 older siblings, who are all married and starting families of their own. As a child I attended Catholic school at St. Francis of Assisi in Vista and became heavily involved with my family at the parish. I was an altar server and took full advantage of every opportunity to help out around the parish. After the passing of my mother when I was in 7th grade, the family dynamic started to change, which caused a spiraling of changes over the next couple of years, such as moving to San Marcos, going to public school, and making new friends. After graduating high school, I attended community college for one year to study broadcast journalism, followed by a year of working for a traveling youth ministry organization named Reach, where I and a team of young adults led retreats for high school Confirmation students. After that, I worked for a year as coordinator of youth ministry at St. Francis in Vista.



During my time in youth ministry, I started to discern what vocation God was calling me to. As I started to build a prayer life and strengthen my relationship with God, I began to realize a possible call to the priesthood. I then went through the application process and was accepted into the program for priestly formation. I spent the next 3 years living at the house of formation, St. Francis Center, located on the campus of the University of San Diego where I studied philosophy. After graduating in 2019 with a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy with a minor in Theology, I was sent to Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon for four years of Theological studies and formation. I was ordained as a Transitional Deacon on December 17, 2022, at Mater Dei Parish, and I was ordained a priest on June 2, 2023, at Good Shepherd Parish. After many years in the program of priestly formation for the Diocese of San Diego, my passion and zeal for a life of priestly service continue to deepen as my relationship with Christ increases in intimacy. Having concluded my theological studies and finally ordained a priest, I feel a greater sense of excitement and joy about what future plans the Lord has for me. I know these experiences will help me to always continue to grow closer to our Lord and they will lead me to a life of sacrifice, service, and love for you, the people of God.

JUNE 10, 2023

Beginning with the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council, the Church has come to a renewed appreciation of the importance of lay involvement in the work of evangelization. In our days, when there are so few clerics to evangelize such great multitudes and to carry out the pastoral ministry, the role of catechists is of the highest importance." (n.4)

To begin your journey in serving the Church as a catechist please consider taking the Basic Catechist Course - Hybrid Model beginning June 10. We meet four times in person and the rest of the classes we meet on Zoom.

Parents are the first teachers of the faith, if you would like to learn more about the teachings of the Catholic Church so to better catechize your children at home, please consider taking this class. Grandparents are also welcome to join in this study in the faith.

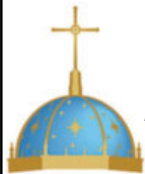
