
Welcome to OUR LADY of GRACE!



formation. God willing, he will be ordained a priest for the Diocese of San Diego in June 2019. A short biography follows.

I was born on Oct 5, 1989 in Maasin, Southern Leyte, Philippines and was raised in Chula Vista, CA. I was baptized in Our Lady of the Assumption Parish-Cathedral. My parents are Victor and Blesilda Napuli and I have a younger brother, Ryan. My family attends Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Chula Vista where I was blessed to be involved in the music ministry, bringing the Eucharist to the sick and homebound. and serving as Master of Ceremonies in liturgies. After high school, I moved to Stockton, CA to pursue musical studies at the Conservatory at the University of the Pacific. It was during this time that I felt the call to discern God's will for me in a deeper way. Following graduation, I entered a House of Formation with the Stockton Diocese, and completed my Philosophy/Pre-Theology at St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park, CA. During my studies there, I was involved with sacred music, the Schola Cantorum, and ministries to a local school. Spiritual direction helped me to grow in prayer and a deeper understanding of God's call. It was during this time that I discerned the need to return to my home and study for the Diocese of San Diego. Besides music and playing the violin, I enjoy Sacred studying Philosophy (especially Scripture, Thomistic and Aristotelian philosophy), history, and languages. I hope one day, if it is God's will, to become a humble and holy priest in service to others, especially the poor.
