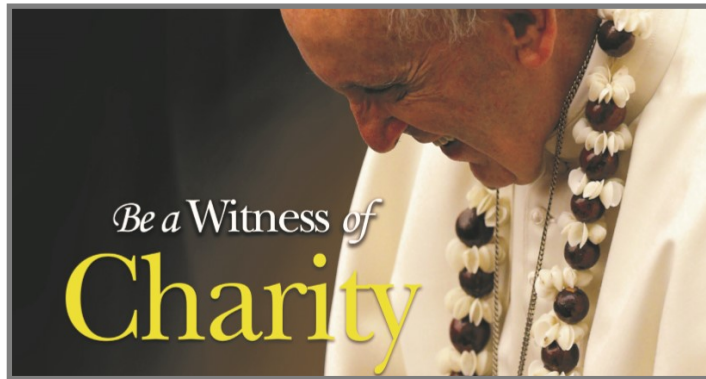

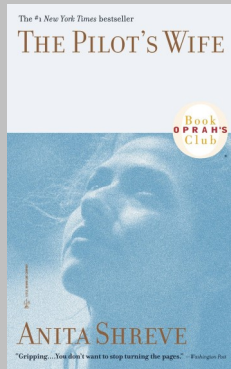


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR CONVALESCENT HOME SERVICES

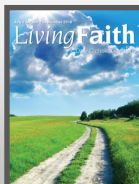
