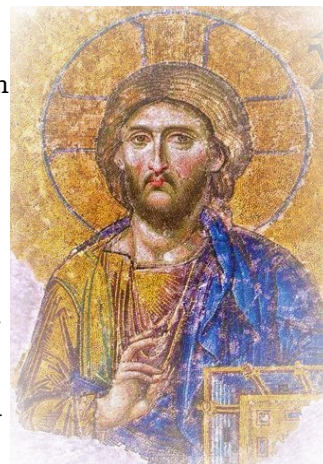
Welcome to OUR LADY of GRACE!

FROM *the* PASTOR

VERY REV. PETER M. MCGUINE

Dear Parishioners,

Last weekend at all the Masses, I was pleased to share with you the news that the next pastor of Our Lady of Grace Parish will be Fr. Lauro Minimo. Fr. Minimo is currently serving as the Director of Priestly Vocations for the Diocese of San Diego and Vice-Rector for the priestly formation program at St. Francis Center located on the USD campus. I look forward to welcoming Fr. Minimo to OLG in the coming weeks and months to help facilitate a smooth transition, effective July 1.

The youngest of five children, Fr. Lauro Minimo was born in Olongapo City, Philippines, on May 19, 1974. At the age of fourteen he immigrated to the United States with his family. Fr. Minimo

graduated from Rancho Verde High School in Moreno Valley, CA in 1992. After a few years of study at Riverside Community College, he transferred to the University of California, Irvine, where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Biological Sciences in 1997. His work in the biotechnology industry

led him to move to San Diego in 2002.

In late 2006, a "re-conversion experience" eventually led Fr. Minimo to consider a possible call to the priesthood. After a few years of discernment, he was accepted as a candidate for priestly formation for the Diocese of San Diego. Two years of philosophical studies at USD while at St. Francis Center and four years of theological studies and priestly formation at Mount Angel Seminary in Mount Angel, OR followed. It was at Mount Angel Seminary where he earned a Master of Divinity degree in 2014. In May of that same year, Fr. Minimo was ordained a priest for the Diocese of San Diego by Most. Rev. Robert H. Brom.

Fr. Lauro's first assignment was at St. Michael Church in Poway where he served as associate pastor for two years. In 2016, he was appointed to serve as the Director of Priestly Vocations for the Diocese of San Diego and Vice-Rector for the diocesan priestly formation program at St. Francis Center. At Bishop McElroy's invitation, he is also currently pursuing a licentiate in Canon Law at the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC.

Grateful for his several assignments to date, he is very excited about his new assignment as pastor of Our Lady of Grace Parish and School.

An Investment Worth Making

It's not uncommon to identify individuals, or groups of people, as unworthy of our time and attention. Sometimes these folks just plain bore us to tears. But more often, we view them as freeloaders, untrustworthy, or even bad to the bone. Jesus was criticized for dining with the wrong people: prostitutes (immoral), tax collectors (unpatriotic), and sinners (generally unsavory types). Jesus tells a story of a feast thrown for a "worthless" son to explain why he himself chooses to "waste" time on the undeserving. The lost need finding, and the dead need life restored. "Hospitality opens the gates of paradise," wrote Orthodox Elder Amphilochius of Patmos. Set another place at your table.

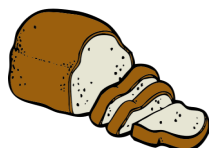

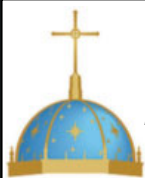

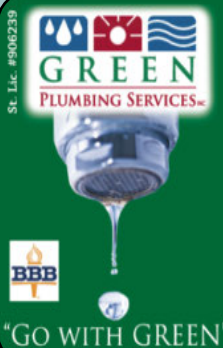
