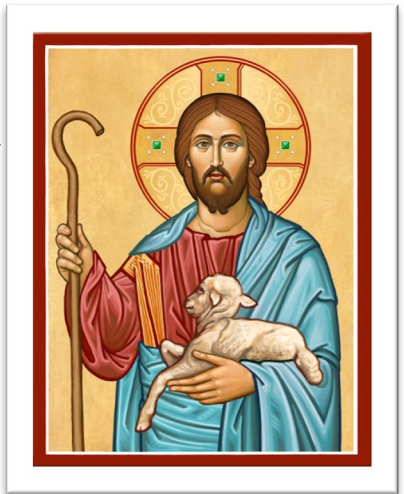
Welcome to all members and visitors who are joining us for the celebration of the Eucharist.

Pentecost Sunday

GROW:

The Solemnity of Pentecost is about the gift of the Spirit in our lives. St. Paul reminds us that despite the variety of gifts we have received, we are one Body. To make sense of this, consider that on a human level, some of us are introverts, while others are extroverts. Each personality type has particular gifts and struggles. Sometimes, our differing personality types can grate on each other, causing tension. And yet, how often do others who are our *Îcddcg]hYgî fYa]bX`i g`cZ* truths we often forget? (Speaking as an extrovert, I need introverts to remind me that you can often learn more from quiet listening than talking out loud.) So, too, with spiritual gifts! As we consider the ways God has gifted each of us, let us remember that the differences between us have a specific purpose: to equip all of us to grow

and experience the fullness of life in Christ.

GO:

In our first reading, we see that the Holy Spirit enables the disciples to speak in languages they did not know. While they were given an extraordinary spiritual []Z`hc`Xc`gcZ`hcXUmîg` missionaries serving in foreign lands must learn the local language to effectively minister among the people they serve. WARNING REGARDING FRADULENT GROUP POSING AS PRIESTS AND BISHOP



DIocese OF SAN DIEGO

The faithful of the Diocese of San Diego are asked to exercise caution with a group of men fraudulently posing as Catholic priests and bishop.

They claim to be Guadalupan Missionaries of the Most Holy Sacrament (MGSS) and are offering sacraments to Catholic families in exchange for money. The public is advised that any sacraments conferred by these men are invalid and illicit.

These group of men-some of them ordained priests but now laicized, have formed their own sect and reside in Rosarito but are not in communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

Reports of these fraudulent priests have been sighted in our diocese and the public must contact their pastor should you become aware of any incidents. Some of the fraudulent priests names are: Bishop Lauro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa, Raymundo Figueroa Pérez.

If anyone is a victim of fraud relating to these priests, please contact the authorities.
