

May is Dedicated to Mary, Our Mother

Why is the month of May devoted to Mary?

Christian devotion to Mary goes back to the early third century. In his encyclical, Mense Maio, 1965, Saint Pope Paul VI acknowledged that the month of May has traditionally been a time when the Church has urged its people to offer prayers and acts of devotion honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary.

What is Mary's role in the story of Redemption? Mary is a pivotal figure in the story of Redemption: through her, the Word of

God the Father was made incarnate by the power of the Holy Spirit. Mary's "fiat," her obedient submission to the Providential Will of God, was that critical moment when God was made flesh and inaugurated the

fulfillment of our redemption.


