Allergies—The first morning Mass of the Sunday or feast day will always be incense-free.

Finance Council Opening

The Finance Council of the parish is established to assist the pastor in the administration of the temporal aspects of parish life, including our parish school. Meeting four to five times per year, members of this Council review and approve budgets and financial reports for both the church and school. In addition, the Council is responsible for advising staff on issues related to human resources, legal concerns, internal controls and procedures, risk management, and the stewardship of parish facilities. 
