

#### Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

GROW: Back in 2018, a Christmastime video about gratitude went viral. A young Dad wakes up covered in wrapping paper to discover his similarly adorned wife and kids. He runs through the house, "unwrapping" the electricity, running water, his shoes ... and a car! Today's Gospel reminded me of this, and of all the times the Lord has provided: whether it is something ordinary like food in the fridge or something extraordinary like the birth of our sons. But how often do I acknowledge that all these gifts come from God? I am guessing all 10 of the lepers in today's Gospel felt much gratitude and joy after they were healed. But only one, a foreigner no less, returned to Jesus to give thanks to God. Likewise, today's readings remind us to return to God

with gratitude for all the blessings in our lives both extraordinary and ordinary.



**GO:** Hearing the account in Kings today, I picture Naaman plunging into the

Jordan – not just once but seven times! What if he'd stopped after one, or two, or four? We hear in the Gospel of 10 other lepers, all of whom raised their voices shouting "Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!" In both cases, those seeking healing showed faith in God, persevering against all odds. This perseverance also is evident in the second reading, where Saint Paul bears great suffering for the sake of the Gospel and the salvation of others. These readings challenge us to persevere in our faith - through prayer and our witness to others we encounter. God will not 8:00 am, 11:00 am, 5:30 pm always answer our prayers the way we want or expect at least not the first time. We need to jump back in like Naaman, trusting that God will give us what we need.

**PRAY:** We quickly turn to God when things go wrong. Next time something good happens, turn to God with the same urgency and say a prayer of thanks.

**St. Mother Théodore Guérin,** who became the eighth American Saint and the first Saint from the State of Indiana on October 15, 2006.

If you ever doubt what God has called you to do, then Mother Théodore Guérin is a saint for you. When this French sister immigrated, with hesitation, to Indiana in



1840, she opened what would become Saint Mary-of-the-Woods College, the first chartered school of higher education for women in the state. Guérin wrote, "It is astonishing that this remote solitude has been chosen for a novitiate and especially for an academy. All appearances are against it." It became the first women's college to offer journalism courses and degree work in secondary education, and was a pioneer in distance education, offering independent study in 1973 (talk about prescient!). Trust God's vision and your role in plans longer-term than anyone can imagine.




