FROM the PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

The recent revelations of decades of the sexual abuse of minors in the Church by clergy in the state of Pennsylvania has shaken to the core the Catholic community and People of Good Will everywhere. The problem has been compounded in Pennsylvania and elsewhere by bishops who failed to protect minors and other vulnerable adults through proper and appropriate oversight. In some cases, the bishops themselves were the perpetrators.

Here in San Diego, all of this seems like "Part Two." In September 2007, the Diocese of San Diego paid nearly \$200 million to 144 people who said they were sexually abused by clergy members under lax supervision from the church. As part of the settlement, the Diocese published a complete list of priests with credible accusations against them. This list included names of clergy from the Diocese of San Diego and the Diocese of San Bernardino, as these now separate dioceses were one until 1978. About a week ago, Bishop McElroy added eight more names of clergy to that list who for one reason or another were not included in the list of 2007. This was recently reported in the San Diego Union Tribune, and a complete list is posted on the diocesan website, www.sdcatholic.org.

A sad reality is that the name of a former pastor of our parish is on that list. While I am not privy to the nature of the allegations against Msgr. Thomas Moloney, pastor of OLG from Jan 1966 until his death in April 1986, the allegations against him were part of the 2007 settle-

Another reality is that our parish center, built in the late 1970's, bears the name of Msgr. Moloney. Shortly after the time of his death in 1986, naming the parish center after the second pastor of the parish seemed like an appropriate way to honor the man who oversaw its construction. No one saw or knew of any reason not to name the building after him.

Times have changed, and so must the name of our parish center. Because of the reality of credible allegations against Msgr. Moloney, I have made the decision to return the name of Moloney Center to simply "Parish Center" effective immediately. No parishioner, employee, student or visitor should have to enter and take part in activities in a building that seemingly honors one who very likely harmed another person or persons sometime in his nearly 43 years of priestly ministry to the people in the Diocese of San Diego.

As you might imagine, this was not an easy decision to make. While not easy, I know to the core of my being it is the right decision. Please continue to pray for victims of abuse—that they might know healing and peace—and for the heads of our Church, families, state and nation to protect the children and vulnerable adults entrusted to their care. Their dignity as human beings demands nothing less.

Our Lady of Grace, Mother of the Church, pray for us!




