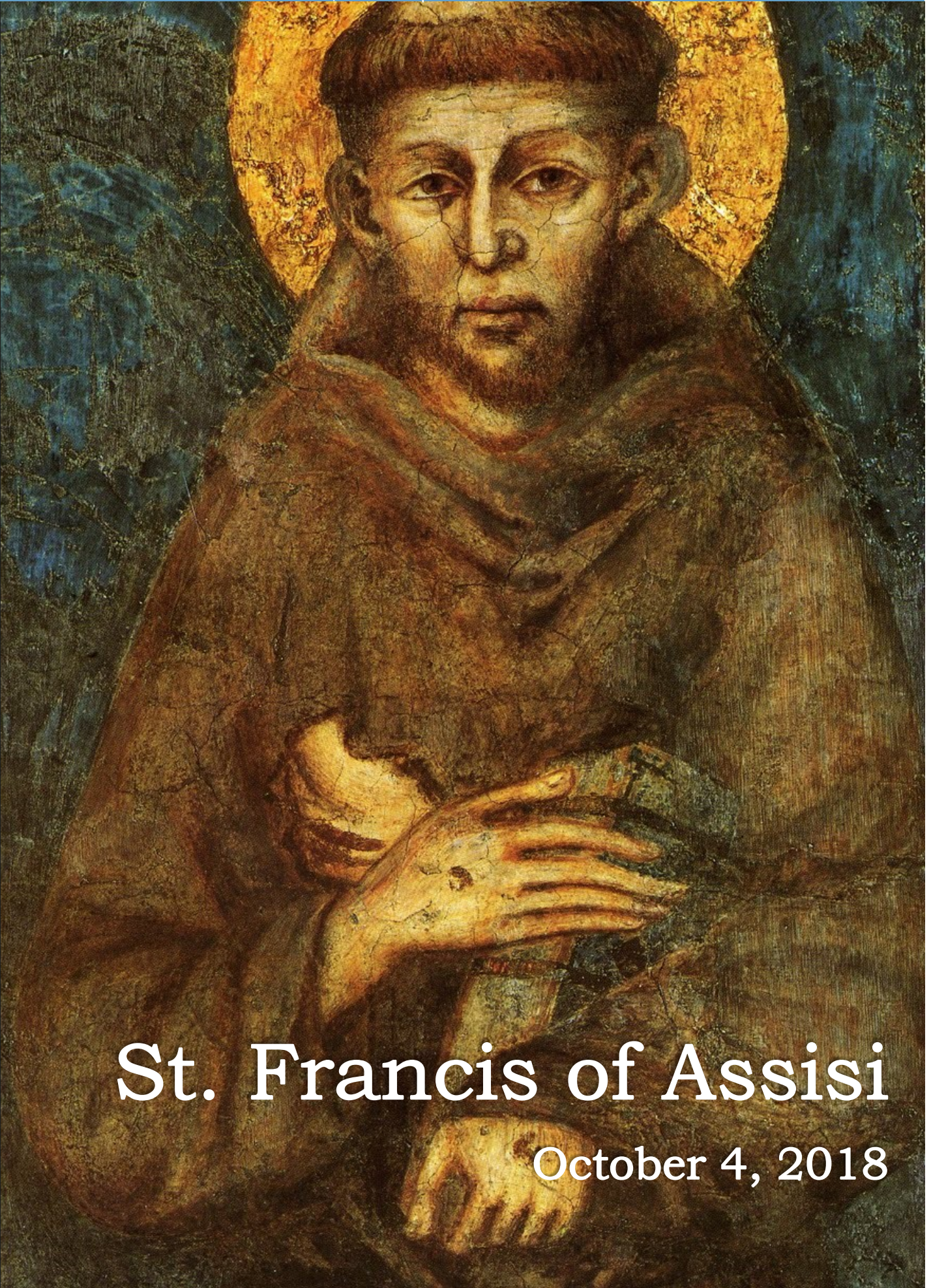

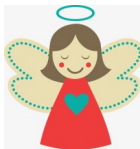
Altar Servers Needed!

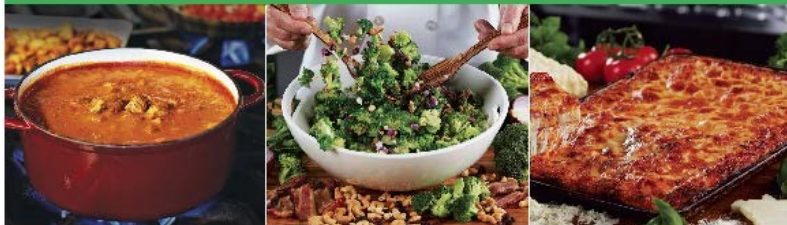

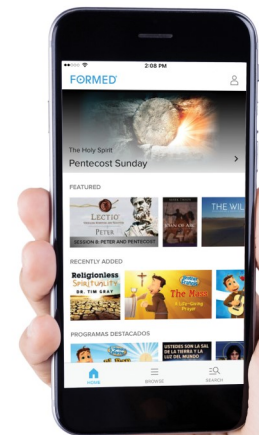
